A meeting of Academic Council was held on 16th February, 2018, at 2.30 p.m. in the Conference Hall of Mechanical Building of Cummins College of Engineering for Women. Following members were present for the meeting.

Dr. Vikram Gadre & Mr. Sachin Lodha communicated their inability to attend the meeting.

Following points were discussed and decisions were taken in the meeting:

Point No. 1] : To confirm the minutes of previous Academic Council meeting held on 25th May 2017.

Decision : Minutes of previous Academic Council meeting held on 25th May 2017 were confirmed.

Point No. 2] Review on Courses offered and Result of Sem-I of FY B Tech, S Y B Tech and F Y M Tech. AY 2017-18.

Discussion : Result of FY B Tech Sem-I of AY 2017-18 was presented.

In the subject Chemistry-I failure percentage is 18% even after reexamination. Committee members expressed their concern about very high failure rate.

Discussion : Dr. A. Ganesh and Dr. Varsha Patil recommended that while question paper setting at least 60% questions should be of average difficulty level.

Decision : Mr. Datta Kuvalekar suggested to check the curriculum, examination scheme, question paper and evaluation process of Chemistry-I.

SY B Tech and FY M Tech Sem-I AY 2017-18 were presented and following discussions were held:

The result of SY B Tech Sem-I (All Programmes) was found satisfactory except Digital Techniques of SY B Tech Instrumentation and Control. Failure in Digital Techniques is about 56%. The members suggested to take review of question paper and evaluation process of this subject.

Decision : It is decided to do audit of question papers. It is also decided to conduct training and discussion sessions on question paper setting.

Point No. 3] : Review on Result Analysis of FY B Tech and FY M Tech AY 2016-17.

Discussion : Overall result of FY B Tech AY 2016-17 was presented and discussed:

FY M Tech results AY 2016-17 was presented and discussed.

Committee members found result satisfactory.

Point No. 4] : Audit courses to be offered at Sem-I and II at T Y B Tech.

Discussion : Considering the required skill sets for placement and higher studies, audit course with modules on communication skills, quantitative aptitude, technical communication, logical reasoning, data interpretation was proposed.

Dr. Varsha Patil advised to keep options to the students for module selection.

Decision : It is decided to introduce audit course at T Y B Tech (All Programmes) with above modules.

Point No. 5] : AICTE Swayam - on line courses to be offered as elective courses from T Y B Tech onwards (Equivalence to courses offered in structure with same credit)

Discussion : All the members appreciated the concept of introducing the elective courses at TY B Tech level from list of AICTE-Swayam On-line courses.

Decision : It is decided to provide one of the open elective courses from available AICTE-Swayam courses, at TY B Tech level.

The conduction of ISE and ESE of offered AICTE-Swayam courses will be done by the internal Faculty.

Point No. 6] : Internship to the students after TY B Tech (All Programmes)

Decision : The following decisions were taken related to Internship:

- a) Internship is mandatory for the students of all programmes
- b) Students should go for Internship in Summer, after ESE of TY B Tech Sem-II
- c) Durations of Internship is from 8 - 12 weeks (2-3 Months)
- d) Faculty member should visit the industry to monitor the internship work.
- e) Student should submit the Certificate of 'Internship Completion'

If student is not able to get an internship, department should offer summer project to the students.

Point No. 7] : Review on NAAC Accreditation Report:

Decision : NAAC Committee visited to the College on 13th and 14th October, 2017. NAAC has awarded Grade-A to the College.

Dr. M B Khambete shared the NAAC - strengths and weaknesses Report with Academic Council members.

Point No. 8] : Following additional point was discussed and decision was taken in the meeting:


Point No. (i) : NBA Committee visit.

Decision : Dr. M.B. Khambete informed Academic Council about the NBA committee visit on 9th, 10th & 11th February, 2018 to evaluate undergraduate programs in Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering and Information Technology.

Decision : It is decided to schedule the next AC meeting on Saturday, Dated 07/04/2018 at 11.00 am.
