Point No. 1]:

Point No. 2]

To approve T.Y. B.Tech Progamme Structure of (All Programmes) to

be offered from the A.Y. 2018-19.

Discussion:

Following suggestion were given by members

The number, of course options under any 'Open elective' or under programme electives should be same for all the

programmes.

 Under programme Elective-II at T.Y. B.Tech "Swayam" online course can be offered. One faculty member should be assigned to every Swayam course. Examination for the course should be conducted by the College.

Course title 'Miniproject' in the program structure is to be revised as 'Miniproject & Seminar' for E&TC & Instrumentation

and for remaining programmes as 'Seminar'.

Decision

T.Y. B.Tech prgrammme Structure Semester - I & II (All Programmes) to be offered from the A.Y. 2018-19 is approved by all the Academic Council members with suggested revisions.

Point No. 3]: To approve contents of courses at T.Y. B.Tech. (All Programmes)

Discussion:

Heads of Departments presented course contents

 Mr. Sachin Lodha suggested to change the course title 'Statistics in Computer Science' to 'Statistics for Computer Science' at T.Y. B.Tech. Computer Engineering.

Decision

T.Y. B.Tech Course contents of Semester - I & II (All Programmes) with above changes & suggestions are approved.

Point No. 4]:

To approve courses to be offered as open elective under HS of T.Y. B.Tech from the A.Y. 2018-19.

Discussion:

 Dr. Anita Patil presented contents of all proposed courses under HS open elective to be offered in T.Y. B.Tech. Semester-I.
Following Courses were proposed under HS open elective

(i) Entrepreneurship Development

(ii) Introduction to Digital Marketing

(iii) Intellectual Property Rights

(iv) Project Management

 Dr. Varsha Patil suggested to use assessment methods viz. group discussions, presentations, games etc. other than paper pencil tests for open electives.

 Dr. Varsha Patil recommended to adopt a mentor system for IPR Course.

Decision

After an exhaustive discussion on open elective under HS the courses & their contents are approved by all the Academic Council members.

Point No. 5]: To discuss passing rule of Re-ESE and Summer Term Examinations.

Discussion:

• Dr. Ajit Bhosale presented result analysis of Re-ESE and Summer Term Examination conducted in last two years.

As per the passing rule for Re-ESE [Rule Book- Page No. 11 - 12 Point No. (i)], the student should score minimum 50% marks of total of ISE & ESE marks for passing the course. However, for regular examination minimum 40% marks of total of ISE & ESE marks are required for passing the course. After reviewing the result analysis, Director Dr. Madhuri Khambete suggested to keep passing rule for reexamination & summer term same as regular examination.

Decision

 It is decided to keep passing criterion same for regular examination, Re-ESE as well as Summer Term of Semester I-II from A.Y. 2018-19 for all the classes of UG & PG Programmes.

Following additional point was discussed and the decision was taken at Point No. 6]: the meeting:

Point No. (i): Discussion: Review on result of Chemistry - I &II for the A.Y. 2017-18.

- Dr. Malini Bapat presented result analysis of F.Y. B.Tech. Chemistry - I & II for the A.Y. 2017-18.
- Passing percentage in Chemistry I & II was found very less ()
- After reviewing the result analysis, Academic Council members discussed and recommended to maintain an appropriate difficulty level in setting the question papers of Chemistry - I &
- Further members also suggested not to set the lengthy papers for the said course.

Decision

It is decided to provide guidelines based on the above observations for question paper setting to all faculty members.
