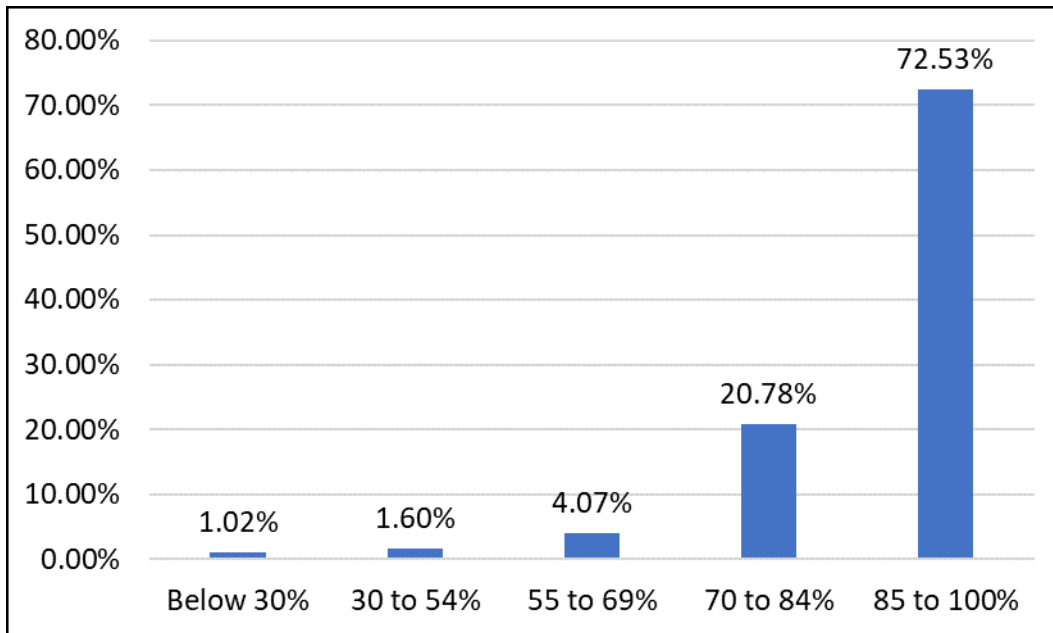




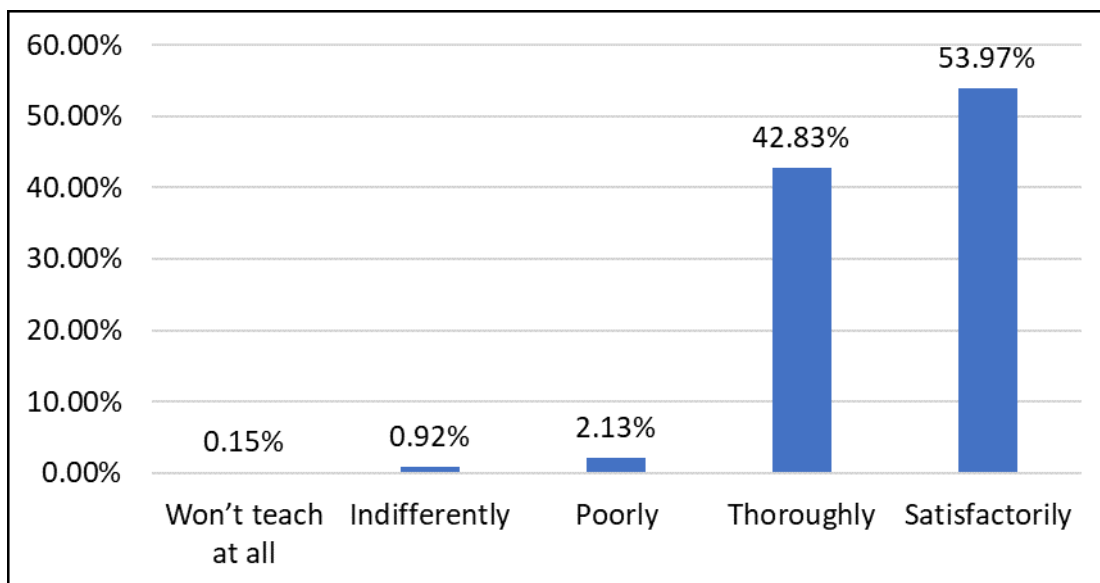

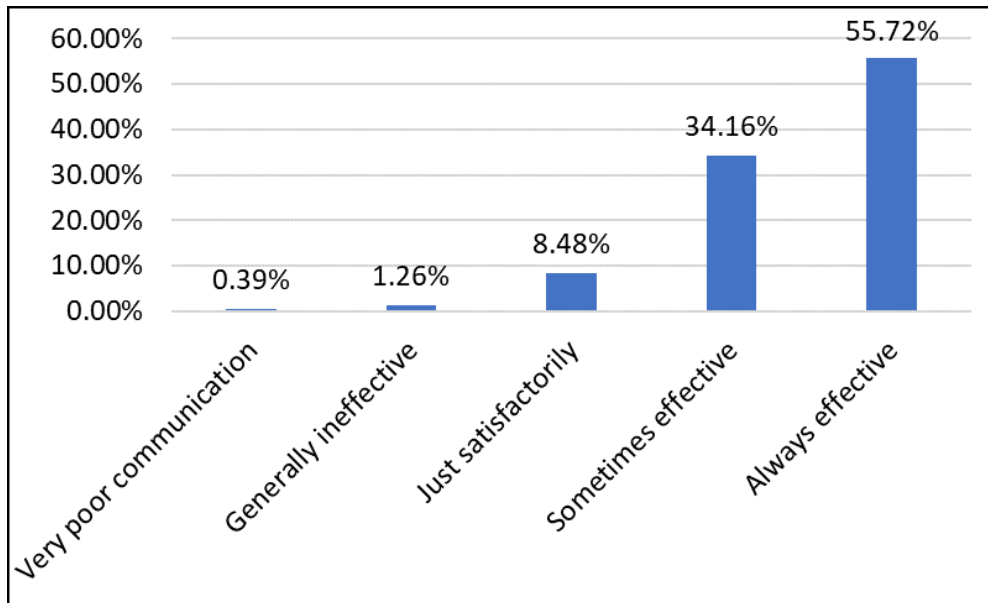
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



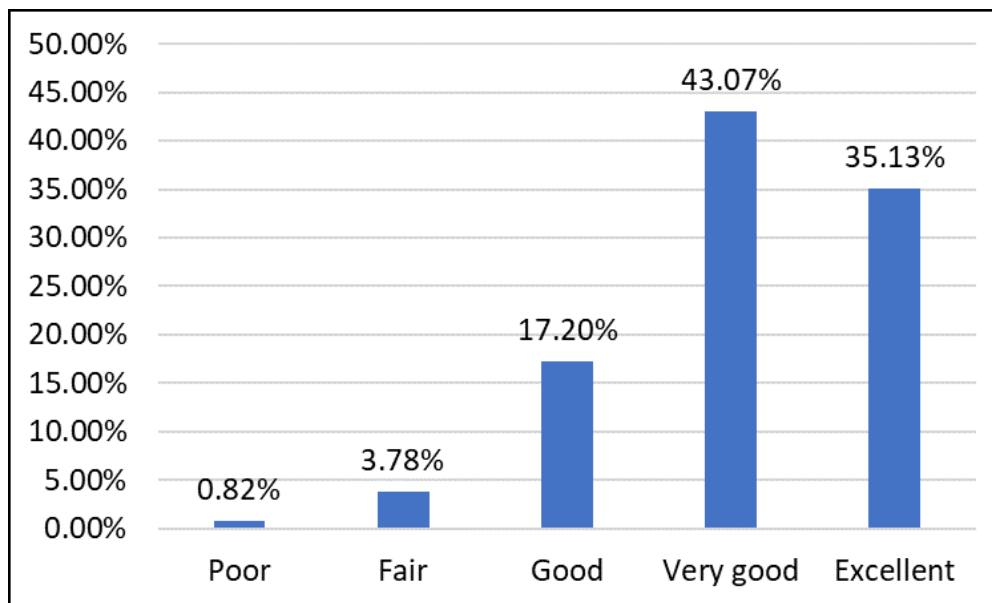

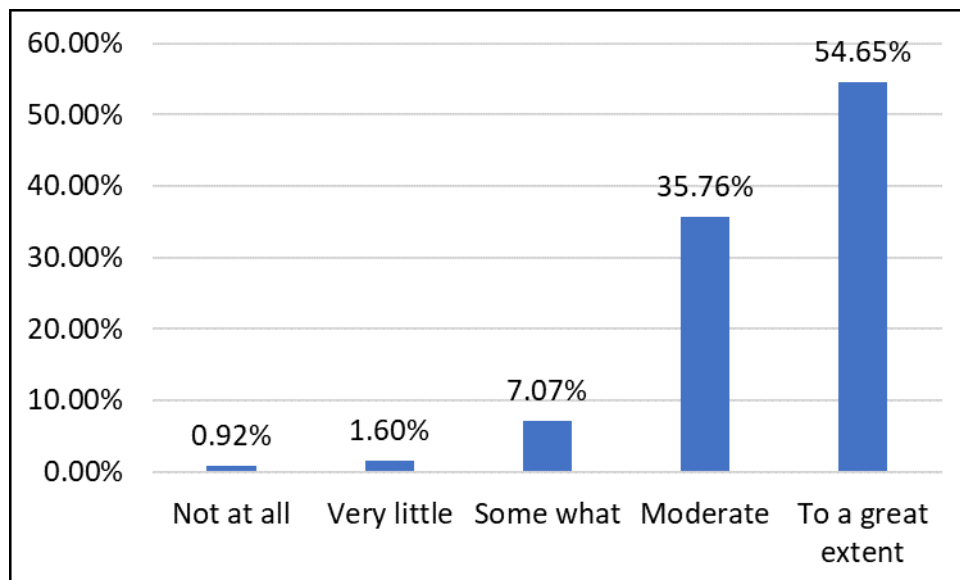
16. Does the institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.



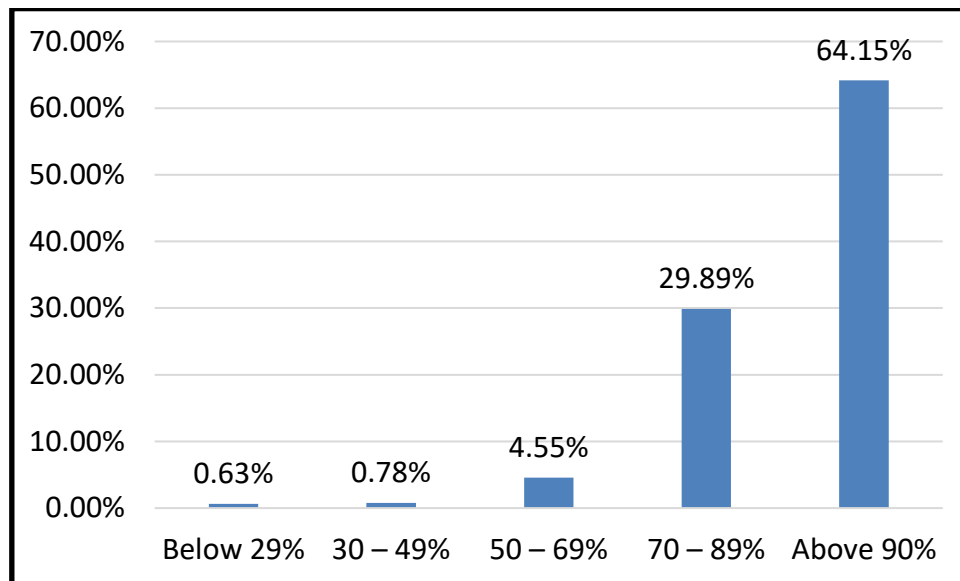
